New Business:

- A. Lake Update:
 - a. They're working on the new dame area of the park by old bridges, working on the ball field grading.
 - b. It was brought up to put stone around point in northeast corner of park to new dam.
 - c. The bid for the river side dredging will go out early August with work to be done over winter.
 - d. The restoration of the new wet land area will be done in October.
 - e. We will need to work on the bid for maintenance work on the project.
- B. Terry Kringle gave an update on the Fundraising Committee.
 - a. Bruce Company donated \$20.00 in trees and wants to go over the landscaping plans.
- C. Update on shocking & stocking fish, monitoring lake water, restoration and plantings:
 - a. Three separate times, fish have been shocked and transferred, with one scheduled for July 6th and 17th. We also talked about stocking fish and have some very good prices. Dave Eustice and Rick Francois stated we shouldn't need to stock Flat Head minnows and to cut back on Blue Gills but stock more game fish. We will need more "No Fishing" signage around lake.
 - b. It was confirmed, there shouldn't be any motors or fishing on the lake for one year. April and Howard will come up with the wording for next meeting. The consensus was the monitoring of the lake and water needs to get started now. With school out this might be a problem for volunteers. Howard will call water commissioner at University of Wisconsin for help. The contractor has been working on restoration area and plantings on the north shore line and along the berm.
 - c. Discussion held on the educational opportunities and came up with some kind of display with the help of Department of Natural Resource at the community picnic.
