NEW BUSINESS:

1. Tour village parks – The committee toured all the parks and reviewed the concept plans for the parks.

CONTINUING BUSINESS:

1. Community Development Goals and Actions #2 – Continue development of plan for Community Park playground, placement of tennis courts and basketball courts and lake trails
 - a. The Liaise Committee recommends that when new basketball courts are built they be put in where the old Community Park tennis courts were for the following reasons:
 - i. There are already lights there
 - ii. The land is relatively flat
 - iii. This location is centrally located within the village
 - iv. The surface could be used for a skating rink in the winter
 - v. Small courts could be put in the neighborhood parks
 - vi. The surface could be used for the Community Picnic tent
 - b. When new tennis courts are built the committee is recommending they be placed in Sugar River Park south of the parking lot.
 - c. The lake trails should be the priority when considering putting in trails. Coordination with the Lake Committee should take place.
 - d. There should be consideration of a joint meeting for January
